The Northwestern Homecoming Association is pleased to extend to your school an invitation to enter one senior girl as a contestant in the 71st Annual Miss Cinderella Pageant at Northwestern Oklahoma State University in Alva, Oklahoma. The 2023 NWOSU Homecoming activities are scheduled for **October 5, 6, and 7, 2023**.

Each contestant who competes in the 2023 Miss Cinderella Pageant will receive a \$2,000 tuition scholarship (up to \$1,000 per semester) to NWOSU - Alva to be used her freshman year. Other winners which include 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th runners up, as well as, Talent, Interview, and Miss Congeniality will receive additional scholarships and waivers. The 2023 Miss Cinderella will receive a total of eight semesters of tuition scholarship to NWOSU - Alva, as well as, a two semester semi-private room scholarship to be used her freshman year.

The Miss Cinderella Pageant is not affiliated with the Miss Oklahoma Pageant.

The principal or superintendent from the contestant's school must certify the contestant on the **Certification of Local Winner** form to be considered entered in the pageant. The pageant is limited to the first 36 schools that certify their local winners.

- **Talent Music (if applicable)** – Flash Drive with two (2) high definition audio copies or two (2) CD's with high quality audio of your accompaniment or background music. Please **do not** get music from **Spotify** as that format often is not compatible.
