Master of Counseling Psychology SPRING, 2010 Applicants

All Spring MCP applicants (**Those planning to take classes in the Summer or Fall**) must have completed application materials to Dr. Mark Davis, Coordinator of Counseling Education, no later than the Spring deadline of Friday, March 26. Interviews will be scheduled for Thursday and Friday, April 8 and 9. Remember: Potential MCP students can only enroll in 9 hours without going through the interview process and being granted admission into the program.

Application Materials include all of the following:

1. Letter from Dr. Rod Murrow, Dean of the Graduate School notifying you of acceptance into NWOSU's Graduate School. (Will be sent directly to Dr. Davis from Graduate Office)
2. Miller's Analogy Test (MAT) or Graduate Record Exam (GRE) scores must be on file with the Graduate Office. NOTE: Scores must be in the 25th percentile for "unconditional" admission. Applicants with scores falling below the 10th percentile will not be offered an interview.
3. A formal letter of intent stating your professional goals and reasons for pursuing the MCP degree. Within the letter provide a careful assessment of your perceived strengths and weaknesses as a potential graduate student and as a potential counseling professional.
4. Three letters of recommendation from those who are most familiar with your academic abilities or potential to be successful in the field of professional counseling. (Past or current professors or employers are typically those best able to write the letters).
5. A sample of your writing ability such as a term paper or research paper listing you as the principle or lead researcher/writer.
