## **NWOSU Student ITV Policy**

Northwestern Oklahoma State University (NWOSU) Interactive Television (ITV) courses are taught between two or more classrooms equipped with video-conferencing technology. The video-conferencing technology utilized allows the remote students to simultaneously receive instruction with the students at the originating site.

Students must realize when using technology, occasional problems may occur. These will be resolved as soon as possible.

Due to the nature of the ITV courses, homework, exams, and other course materials are exchanged via a courier service. Depending on the type of materials, an instructor may need 1-2 weeks to have materials graded and returned.

The equipment and environment of ITV courses are different than in a face-to-face teaching environment. These are suggestions for making the online learning environment more conducive to learning:

- Keep noise to a minimum for there is an open microphone in the classroom at all times.
- When speaking, identify yourself and your location for the instructor and for your classmates at the other sites.
- Avoid interruptions of others. Only one person can speak and be understood at any given time. If two people speak at once, their voices drown each other out over the audio system.
