For installation and identification purposes, all pieces must include the category, title of the work & your name in the upper right hand corner on the back side.

All photography must be matted or mounted, and photos must be at least 5"x7". No frames allowed on photography. Visual Art should be framed or matted/mounted and ready to hang. Only 3-Dimensional work is exempt from hanging/mounting, and it must be labeled. <u>Special attention should always be paid to the presentation of your art work</u>. Questions? # **21st Annual Spring Art Show Specifications**

- Students, employees (current and retired) and alumni from all Northwestern locations may participate.
- Show is open March 4-29. All winning entries will be moved to the Runnymede for a Winners' Show Friday, April 5, during First Friday/Art Walk Events (5-8pm) unless you specifically refuse to display in this show.
- For organizational purposes, artwork may be re-categorized to make categories consistent and alleviate confusion.
- Works will be accepted February 28 (11a-5p) and March 1 (11a-3p) Bring entries to the room provided at the J.W. Martin Library in Alva. If you live out
  of town, you may mail (at your own risk), the pieces to Thomas Cornell, Assistant Professor of Visual Art,, NWOSU, JD218, 709 Oklahoma Blvd., Alva, OK
  73717. You must provide return postage for your piece, or pick it up.
- Ribbons will be awarded to all winners. Only students are eligible for all cash prizes; however, Northwestern employees-retirees-alumni are eligible for the cash prize in the People's Choice Category (\$25).
- If, in the opinion of the judges, none of the entries in a category meet the standards of excellence, no award will be given. Judges may award any place to an entry based on merit.
- Student winners in each category will receive ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> placings and a \$10 cash prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place. Non-student winning entries will
  receive ribbons only. All entries are eligible for the People's Choice Award of a ribbon and \$25 cash prize. Best of Show ribbons will be
  awarded to both a student and non-student winner, with the student winner receiving \$50.

Artisan Crafts, Cartoon/Comics, Coloring, Digital Art, Fiber Art, Quilting, Mixed Media/Collage and Printmaking. <u>In Painting</u>: Watercolor on Paper, Animals/Creature, Architecture, Elements of Design, The Figure/Portraiture, Landscapes/Nature, Still Life. <u>In Works on Paper</u>: Animals/Creature, Architecture, Elements of Design, The Figure/Portraiture, Landscapes/Nature, Still Life. <u>In Photography</u>: Animals/Creature, Architecture, Black and White, Elements of Design, Landscapes, Light, , Macro, Nature, People. <u>Miscellaneous Artwork</u>: Artwork submitted into the show that does not fit any of the list categories available. These items will be judged together – regardless of the medium.

### Rules/Specifications:

- No previously submitted material will be allowed.
- No kits, prints or photocopies are allowed. All artwork must be original including cartoon/comic characters.
- No obscene language or references.
- All photos must be at least 5"x7" and must be matted or mounted. No frames on photos. No exceptions.
- All Fine Arts entries should be framed or matted and ready to hang. Only 3-dimensional work is exempt, and it must be labeled.
- Special attention should always be paid to the presentation of your artwork.
- 2 entries per category, maximum.
- Artwork must be pre-registered no later than Feb. 22. Forms must be delivered to JD218 (via mail, campus mail, in person or by e-mail (tacornell@nwosu.edu) or by online registration at: <u>https://www.nwosu.edu/forms/art-show</u>
- Pieces must be submitted at Alva Campus Library Feb. 28, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. and March 1, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Directions will be provided to the correct room for storage at the Library.
- Only those with previous permission will be allowed to bring artwork later than 3 p.m. on March 1.
- For installation and identification purposes, <u>all entries must have the category name, title of the work and your name in the upper right hand corner</u> on the back side. Three-dimensional items may be entered without this marking; however, the piece must have the same identification provided/attached.
- <u>Artwork not moving to the Winners Show must be picked up on Monday, April 1, before 5:30 p.m. at the J.W. Martin Library.</u> Questions? 580-327-8111 or email <u>tacornell@nwosu.edu</u>.
