

# Undergraduate Scholarships & Financial Aid

- Northwestern has one of the region's best scholarship, financial aid and enrollment incentive programs to help you defray college costs.
- Institutional and state scholarships are available, as well as departmental, athletic, participation and more.
- A \$400 award is available to high school seniors who attend Ranger Preview during fall semester.
- Full-time enrollment and a minimum 2.5 CGPA are required. Application is required each year.
- More than \$1.4 million in institutional aid is dispersed annually.
- 42 percent of total student population received some form of aid.
- Of the 2006-07 freshmen who completed scholarship applications, 89 percent received some type of scholarship or fee waiver.
- There are different types of financial aid available at all three of our campus sites -- institutional, state, and federal in the form of

scholarships, grants, loans and campus work study, so it pays to fill out the FAFSA as soon after Jan. 1 as possible. Northwestern's FAFSA code is 003163.
