SECTION 7: MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

In August 2024, NWOSU began offering an on-line Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree to help meet the needs of students, businesses, and health-care organizations in northwest Oklahoma. The MBA is a 33-hour program that can be completed either in 12 months (for full-time students) or 24 months (for part-time students).

GOALS

- Students will be able to apply analytical and critical thinking skills to make informed decisions that will lead to a sustainable competitive advantage.
- Students will be able to analyze the shifting balance of global economic power and how it impacts the business environment.
- 3. Students will have the ability to integrate and apply learned business models to successfully manage the business environment and solve complex organizational problems.
- Students will develop leadership skills to offer effective and ethical solutions to problems.
- Students will develop communication and collaboration skills to work effectively with diverse team members.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students who do not hold a bachelor's degree in business or accounting from an accredited university (ACBSP or AACSB) must complete the Peregrine CPC exam (\$40). Students must score at a 70% or higher in the common professional component subject areas to pass. Students who do not score satisfactory in each of the CPC subject areas will complete leveling modules. These can cost up to \$375. Modules must be completed by January 1st for summer and fall enrollees and by May 1st for spring enrollees before continuation the program can occur. Note: Some modules serve as prerequisites to specific courses and must be completed prior to enrollment.
