STAFF SATISFACTION



Participants


In 2021, there were 72 respondents; 69 on the Alva Campus, 3 on the Enid campus, and 0 on the Woodward campus.


The chart below indicates staff member's level of agreement with the following statements. The numbers reflect those answering "strongly agree" or "agree."
