### Measure 3: The Action Research Project (ARP)

**What:** The Action Research Project assesses an advanced candidate's ability to identify a problem; research the problem; design a strategy to address the problem; implement the strategy; study the impact of the strategy on the problem. Data collection and analysis are part of the ongoing process of the project. Collaboration between the candidate and a partner school is required. The project requires application of content knowledge gained throughout the advanced program. The project is a requirement for those completing Educational Leadership (Building Level), Reading Specialist, and School Counseling certification programs.

**When:** The ARP is conducted over a period of 2-3 semesters. The advanced candidate presents the results of the project in the final semester of the program (Milestone 3) to the candidate's Advisory Committee and selected stakeholders. A successful ARP is a program completion requirement.

**Data Reporting:** Data from Milestone 3 is reviewed by each advanced program leading to certification and by the EPP. A rubric aligned with CAEP Advanced Standards is used to assess the final Action Research Project presentation. The data are reported by the levels of performance on the rubric. The Teacher Education Assessment Management System (TEAMS) Committee reviews the data on an annual basis and makes recommendations for program improvement to the EPP's policy making body, the Teacher Education Committee, based upon the analysis (Report can be found at https://www.nwosu.edu/school-of-education/education). The data show that advanced candidates scored at the "Target" or "Acceptable" level in each section aligned with CAEP Advanced Standards. The section pertaining to the candidate demonstrating the ability to analyze, interpret, and use data is the area in which more candidates were assessed at the "Acceptable" level than at the "Target" level. The 2020-2021 academic year is the first year of full implementation of the Action Research Project by all three advanced programs (Educational Leadership, Reading Specialist, School Counseling). It is also the first in which a change in the research class (from Introduction to Research to Classroom Research) has been implemented for the advanced programs. The change was made because the Classroom Research course is better aligned with the Action Research Project including analysis, interpretation, and use of data as an integral part of the research process.
