Establishment of Faculty Development Curriculum Program: As part of NWOSU's LASSO (Leadership, Academic Success, and Superior Outcomes) grant initiative, full-time NWOSU faculty have access to the online platform Go2Knowledge. An incentivized curriculum program based on issues identified in NWOSU's LASSO grant application and Go2Knowledge offerings has been developed. The program is divided into four yearly modules with each module consisting of specific on-demand webinars that address pertinent topics such as academic advisement, first generation students, retention of first-year students, help for struggling students, etc. Module 1 started February 1, 2023 and will end September 15, 2023. In addition to completing the prescribed curriculum program, full-time faculty have the option of choosing from over 300 on-demand webinars from Go2Knowledge to complete meaningful faculty development on a schedule that works for them.
