Oklahoma state law requires that all new students who attend Oklahoma colleges and universities for the first time provide proof of immunization for certain diseases. If you cannot verify your immunizations you will need to be re-immunized. Medical, religious and personal exemptions are allowed by law and such requests must be made by filling out the Northwestern Immunization Records form.

To enroll as a full-time or part-time student at Northwestern, Oklahoma law requires students to provide written documentation of vaccinations against Hepatitis B and Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) by filling out the Northwestern <u>Immunization Records form</u>, as well as the <u>Hepatitis B Statement</u>. This applies to all students of any age or at any stage of education. Exemptions from this requirement may be by providing a written statement from a physician stating that the vaccine is medically contraindicated or by signing a waiver. These vaccinations can be obtained from your family doctor or your community's health department.

University housing requires a <u>Meningitis Form</u> to be completed prior to a room being assigned. This form will be sent directly to the Director of Housing. Additional information is available at <u>http://www.nwosu.edu/uploads/housing/menininfo.pdf</u>

All International students are required to have a Tuberculosis Skin Test. They must provide a proof of negative test results in the United States. If test result is positive, the student must have chest x-ray verification indicating that the student does not have TB.
