It must be matted or mounted if not framed/hangable. Only 3-Dimensional work is exempt from hanging/mounting, and it must be labeled. **Special attention should always be paid to the presentation of your art work.**

18th Annual Spring Art Show Specifications

- Students, employees (current and retired) and alumni from all Northwestern locations may participate.
- Show is open **March 7-26**. All winning entries will be moved to the Runnymede for a Winners' Show Friday, **April 2**, during First Friday/Art Walk Events (6-8pm) unless you specifically refuse display in this show.
- For organizational purposes, artwork may be re-categorized to make categories consistent and alleviate confusion.
- **March 3** - Bring entries to the room provided at the **J.W. Martin Library** in Alva. If you live out of town, you may mail (at your own risk), the pieces to Angelia Case, NWOSU, RH 211, 709 Oklahoma Blvd., Alva, OK 73717. *You must provide return postage for your piece, or pick it up.*
- Ribbons will be awarded to all winners. Only students are eligible for all cash prizes; however, Northwestern employees-retirees-alumni are eligible for the cash prize in the People's Choice Category (\$25).
- If, in the opinion of the judges, none of the entries in a category meet the standards of excellence, no award will be given. Judges may award any place to an entry based on merit.
- **Student winners in each category will receive ribbons for 1st thru 3rd placings and a \$10 cash prize for 1st place. Non-student winning entries will receive ribbons. All entries are eligible for the People's Choice Award of a ribbon and \$25 cash prize. Best of Show ribbons will be awarded to both a student and non-student winner, with the student winner receiving \$50.**

Artisan Crafts, Fiber Art, Quilting, Cartoon/Comics, Digital Art, Mixed Media/Collage. **In Painting:** Watercolor, Animals/Creature, Architecture, Elements of Design, The Figure/Portraiture, Landscapes/Nature, Still Life, All other subject areas. **In Works on Paper:** Animals/Creature, Architecture, Elements of Design, The Figure/Portraiture, Landscapes/Nature, Still Life, All other subject areas. **In Photography:** Animals/Creature, Black and White, Landscapes, Cityscapes, Light, Elements of Design, Macro, People, Nature, Still Life, All Other Subject Areas

Rules/Specifications:

- No previously submitted material will be allowed.
- No kits. All artwork must be original including cartoon/comic characters.
- All photos must be at least 5"x7" and be matted or mounted. No frames on photos. No exceptions.
- All Fine Arts entries should be framed or matted and ready to hang. Only 3-dimensional work is exempt, and it must be labeled.
- 2 entries per category, maximum.
- Artwork must be pre-registered **no later than Wednesday, Feb. 24. Forms must be delivered to RH 211** (via mail, campus mail, in person or by e-mail (arcase@nwosu.edu) or by **online registration at: <https://www.nwosu.edu/forms/art-show-entry>**
- Pieces must be submitted at **Alva Library** by 5 p.m. on **Wednesday, March 3. Directions will be provided to the correct room for storage at the Library.**
- Only those *with previous permission* will be allowed to bring artwork later than 5 p.m. on **Wednesday, March 3.**
- For installation and identification purposes, **all entries must have the category name, title of the work and your name in the upper right hand corner on the back side.** Three-dimensional items may be entered without this marking; however, the piece must have the same identification provided/attached.
- Some mats may be purchased from the NWOSU Art Society (**until supply is exhausted**). Contact Angelia Case, RH 211, for information.
- **Artwork not moving to the Winners Show must be picked up on Monday, March 29, before 5:30 p.m. at the J.W. Martin Library. Questions? 580-327-8577 or email arcase@nwosu.edu.**
