

16th Annual Spring Art Show Specifications

- Students, employees (current and retired) and alumni from all Northwestern locations may participate.
- Show is open **March 3-29**. All winning entries will be moved to the Runnymede for a Winners' Show Friday, **April 5**, during First Friday/Art Walk Events (6-8pm) unless you specifically refuse display in this show.
- For organizational purposes, artwork may be re-categorized to make categories consistent and alleviate confusion.
- **Feb. 27** - Bring entries to the room provided at the **J.W. Martin Library** in Alva. If you live out of town, you may mail (at your own risk), the pieces to Angelia Case, NWOSU, FA 211, 709 Oklahoma Blvd., Alva, OK 73717. You must provide return postage for your piece, or pick it up.
- Ribbons will be awarded to all winners. Only students are eligible for all cash prizes; however, Northwestern employees-retirees-alumni are eligible for the cash prize in the People's Choice Category (\$50).
- If, in the opinion of the judges, none of the entries in a category meet the standards of excellence, no award will be given. Judges may award any place to an entry based on merit.
- **Student winners in each category will receive ribbons, as well as \$15 for 1st place; \$5 for 2nd place; \$2 for 3rd place. Non-student winning entries will receive ribbons. All entries are eligible for the People's Choice Award of a ribbon and \$50 cash prize. Best of Show ribbons will be awarded to both a student and non-student winner, with the student winner receiving \$75.**

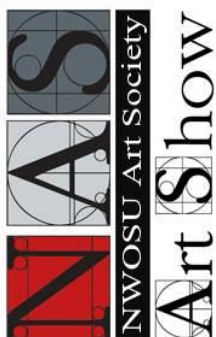

Artisan Crafts, Fiber Art, Quilting, Cartoon/Comics, Digital Art, Mixed Media/Collage. In Painting: Watercolor, Animals/Creature, Architecture, Elements of Design, The Figure/Portraiture, Landscapes/Nature, All other subject areas. In Works on Paper: Animals/Creature, Architecture, Elements of Design, The Figure/Portraiture, Landscapes/Nature, All other subject areas. In Photography: Animals/Creature, Black and White, Landscapes, Cityscapes, Light, Elements of Design, Macro, People, Nature, All Other Subject Areas.

Rules/Specifications:

- No previously submitted material will be allowed.
- No kits. All artwork must be original including cartoon/comic characters.
- All photos must be at least 5"x7" and be must be matted or mounted. No frames on photos. No exceptions.
- 2 entries per category, maximum.
- Artwork must be **pre-registered no later than Wednesday, Feb. 20. Forms must be delivered to FA 211** (via mail, campus mail, in person or by e-mail (arcase@nwosu.edu) or by **online registration** at: <https://www.nwosu.edu/forms/art-show-entry>
- Pieces must be submitted at **Alva Library** by 5 p.m. on **Wednesday, Feb. 27. Directions will be provided to the correct room for storage at the Library.**
- Only those *with previous permission* will be allowed to bring artwork later than 5 p.m. on **Wednesday, Feb. 27.**
- For installation and identification purposes, **all entries must have the category name, title of the work and your name in the upper right hand corner on the back side.** Three-dimensional items may be entered without this marking; however, the piece must have the same identification provided/attached.
- Some mats may be purchased from the NWOSU Art Society (until supply is exhausted). Contact Angelia Case, FA 211, for information.
- **Artwork not moving to the Winners Show must be picked up on Monday, April 1, before 5:30 p.m. at the J.W. Martin Library. Questions? 580-327-8577 or email arcase@nwosu.edu.**
