The Miss Cinderella Pageant has been offering exceptional high school girls an opportunity to participate in a valuable pageant, competing for honors and scholarship awards, since its inception.



Scholarships

- Each contestant who competes will receive a \$2,000 tuition scholarship (up to \$1,000 per semester) to NWOSU-Alva to be used her freshman year.
- The winner of the Miss Cinderella title receives eight semesters of tuition and a one-year room waiver at NWOSU-Alva.
- The first and second runners-up receive six and four semesters of tuition respectively.
- The winners of the talent and congeniality titles each receive a one-year room waiver in addition to the tuition scholarship each contestant receives.




Duties

Contestants must attend all events such as Orientation, Talent Rehearsal, Talent Show, luncheon, dinners, interview, coronation, and the Homecoming parade.

NOTE: The Miss Cinderella Pageant is not affiliated with the Miss Oklahoma system, therefore there is no Health and Fitness Category.

Contestant must be a true H.S. senior female, single, at least 16 years of age by Sept. 1, and never have previously entered the Miss Cinderella Pageant.
