ReachHigher is not an accelerated degree for current students. Students must have a minimum of 72 credit hours, be 21 years of age and not enrolled as a full-time student for at least one year. They must also have a minimum of 2.0 graduation/retention GPA in past college course work. Individual colleges may have other admission requirements.

At the same time, these adults are facing hectic schedules with work, family and other commitments. A new flexible degree completion program called **ReachHigher** can help working adults complete their college education while balancing their already busy lives.

How You Can Help

Returning adult students' needs are different than traditional students. The typical adult working student is pursuing a degree while balancing family, work and other obligations. They have some college experience but may not be familiar with the current enrollment process. Just like you, their time is valuable and limited. The best way to assist a working adult student is to have readily available resources and answers to streamline the enrollment process.

Many returning adult students were forced to leave school due to family, finances, or other obligations. Finishing their college degree is a committed investment toward creating better job opportunities, life skills, or fulfilling a dream. ReachHigher

Beginning in March 2007, nine regional public universities across Oklahoma will offer **ReachHigher**, an adult degree completion program designed specifically for working adults. The program has an eight-week schedule, with convenient evening class times and online courses. Students can enroll in the program five times throughout the year. The curriculum focuses on courses in management, business, communications, leadership, ethics, and data analysis and concludes with a capstone course. Upon completion, graduates will have earned a degree in Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership.
